Research Promotion Policy

The college has institutionalised a Research Promotion Policy to promote the teachers for quality research and innovations.

Key features of the Policy are as under:

- Each faculty member of the college to publish at least one research article in a year in reputed peer-reviewed journals.
- The college shall institute "Annual Best Researcher Award" for the promotion of research. The teacher with a minimum of two research papers in UGC listed/CARE- listed journals shall be eligible to apply for the award. If the total number of eligible candidates from different disciplines is more than four, then the awards may be given in two different categories i.e., 1) Sciences and 2) Humanities and Social Sciences (Including Commerce).
- The 'Best Researcher of the Year' award shall be introduced w.e.f. academic session 2022-23 (on the basis of research output of the session) with a certificate and a cash prize of INR 5000.
- Financial support may be provided in the form of publication fee and for participation in national seminars/ conferences/ workshops/ webinars as notified in the relevant policy of the college vide notification no. MBPGC—154/21-22 dated 09/03/2022.
- College to organise at least one event (preferably online) in every academic session on research methodology, IPRs, entrepreneurship or any other upcoming theme to orient the teachers for quality research.
- Faculty is advised to avoid publishing in bogus/ predatory journals.
- The college to provide a dedicated space on website for highlighting research activities/ achievements of the faculty. The research output of the faculty may be given due prominence through college magazine/ prospectus and other social media platforms.
- Each department may be allowed to subscribe at least one quality research journal related to the respective discipline.
- Faculty may be incentivised for collaborative research/ consultation activities in the form of special support to develop the lab or to subscribe additional number of journals.
- Each department to be provided un-interrupted power supply and Wi-Fi connectivity to facilitate them for quality research pursuits.
- A research coordinator be appointed to initiate all the relevant initiatives encouraging the faculty for quality research.
- All eligible teachers be motivated to apply for research centres in the respective disciplines.
- A teacher awarded with a project of INR 5 lacs or more may be provided additional support for quality research.
- A research corner be established in the central library where the teachers and PG students may access E- resources and research database.
- The Policy is likely to be reviewed and revised periodically to make it more contextual and relevant for the purpose.
